Home Fire Prevention

Home fire prevention tips for throughout the home.

- Install Smoke detectors on every level of the home in stairs, landings, and test them monthly. Change batteries twice a year.
- Store and use all cleaning products and aerosol cans away from heat.
- Replace all frayed, cracked, or broken electrical cords.
- Use outlets safety. Don't plug too many large appliances into an outlet, overload an extension cord, or multi-extension cords in an outlet.
- Keep all lighters and matches in locked or high cabinets away from children
- Use light bulbs with the correct wattage for the fixture.
- Put out cigarettes in ashtrays. Never throw them in the trash.
- Do not use electrical appliances or tools when you or the cord are in water.

Park On Florence Lot Use Restrictions

Livestock and poultry prohibited: No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on any part thereof, except that dogs, cats, or other household pets may be kept, provided they are not kept, bred or maintained for commercial purposes.

City of Broken Arrow Parking Codes

Sec. 23-135. - Parking more than limited periods.

(a)

No person shall park a vehicle on any street for a period of time longer than 24 hours. This section shall not affect parking limits established for shorter periods.

(b)

No person shall park a vehicle on any lot or paved surface smaller than one acre, and used as a residence within a city for a period of time longer than 12 hours unless the vehicle is parked entirely on a paved surface of asphalt, brick, cement, chat, gravel or comparable material as approved by the city manager or designee. This section shall not affect parking limits established for shorter periods.

Park on Florence Trash Service Schedule

Trash pickup is Tuesdays and Fridays

If a route cannot be completed on schedule, trash will be picked up first thing the following morning.

Holiday Schedule

If a holiday falls on a Monday, the Tuesday pickup will be delayed until Wednesday. If a holiday falls on Tuesday or Friday, your trash will be picked up on your next regular pickup day.
