Halloween Safety Tips

- Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks
- Look left, right and left again when crossing and keep looking as you cross.
- Keep heads up and walk, don't run across a street.
- Always walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks then walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible.
- Watch for cars turning or backing. Teach children never to dart out into street or cross between cars.
- Children under 12 should not be alone at night without adult supervision.
- Decorate costumes with reflective tape or stickers.
- Choose face paint and makeup if possible instead of masks which can obstruct views.
- Have kids carry glow sticks or flashlight to help them see and be seen by others.
- Make sure the costume is of the right size to prevent trips and falls.
- Slow down and be alert in residential neighborhoods. Children are excited on Halloween and may move in unpredictable ways.
- Take extra time to look for kids at intersections, medians, and on curbs.
- Enter and exit driveways and alleys slowly and carefully.
- Drive slowly, anticipate heavy pedestrian traffic and turn your headlights on earlier to spot children from greater distances.

The Broken Arrow City Council approved a resolution calling for a November 10 special election, to ask Broken Arrow voters to permanently renew a majority of the Vision 2025 sales tax in Tulsa County. The revenue would be used to hire more police officers and firefighters, as well as fix streets in Broken Arrow.
