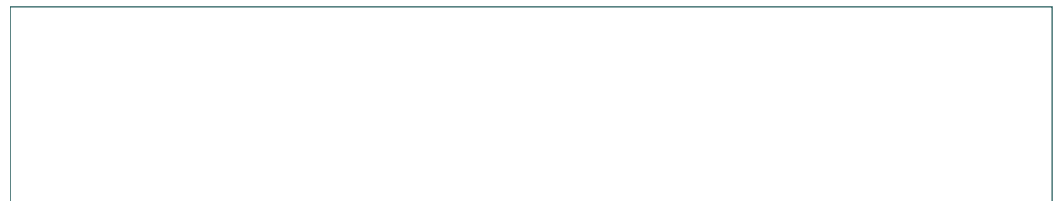

Thanksgiving Safety Tips

- **Thanksgiving is the peak day of the year for home cooking fires.**
- **Unattended cooking was by far the leading contributing factor in cooking fires and fire deaths**
- **Cooking equipment is the leading cause of home structure fires and associated civilian injuries and was the third leading cause of home fire deaths.**
- Stay in the kitchen when you are cooking on the stovetop so you can keep an eye on the food
- Stay in the home when cooking your turkey and check on it frequently.
- Keep children away from the stove. The stove will be hot and kids should stay 3 feet away.
- Make sure kids stay away from hot food and liquids. The steam or splash from vegetables, gravy or coffee could cause serious burns.
- Keep the floor clear so you don't trip over kids, toys, pocketbooks or bags.
- Keep knives out of the reach of children.
- Be sure electric cords from an electric knife, coffee maker, plate warmer or mixer are not dangling off the counter within easy reach of a child.
- Keep matches and utility lighters out of the reach of children — up high in a locked cabinet.
- Never leave children alone in room with a lit candle. Make sure your smoke alarms are working. Test them by pushing the test button.
